According to the Cabinet resolution on December ๘ , ๒๐๒๐ , the country's reform plan was approved. Prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct (revised edition) by specifying a drive to carry out important reform activities ( Big Rock) Reform activity number ๔ : Develop the Thai bureaucratic system to be transparent and free from Benefits, which is goal number ๑, section ๑.๑, “ Every government agency shall declare itself to be an agency that All government officials do not accept gifts and gratuities of any kind in the performance of their duties ( No Gift Policy)” .

To drive reform activities according to the national reform plan above. Create transparency within the agency Create values in performing duties and should act as an honest culture of the Ban Pao Subdistrict Administrative Organization . Therefore, the policy was announced for administrators. All employees, officers, and personnel under their supervision do not accept gifts and gratuities of any kind while performing their duties ( No Gift Policy) both while, before, and after performing their duties. Every festival and special occasion Various , except in cases of necessity and unavoidability, must follow the rules for accepting gifts or gifts and Any other benefits according to the regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister regarding giving or receiving gifts by government officials, ๒๐๐๑, together with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the criteria for receiving gifts. Property or any other benefits according to the ethics of government officials, B.E. ๒๐๒๐

Therefore, this announcement has been made for everyone's knowledge. and for all executives, officers, and personnel under their jurisdiction to hold Continue to strictly follow the policy.
